Keynote Speakers

SARA REARDON PT, DPT, WCS, BCB-PMD





Sara is the owner of NOLA Pelvic Health in her hometown of New Orleans, Laandfounder of The Vagina Whisperer. She is a Doctor of Physical Therapy, earning her Bachelors of Science in 2004 and Doctorate of Physical Therapy in 2007 from Washington University

in St. Louis. She is a board-certified women's health and pelvic floor therapist specializing in the treatment of pelvic floor muscle dysfunction in men and women. She is a TedX Presenter, recipient of the 2019 Alumni Achievement Award from Washington University in St Louis' Program in Physical Therapy and was named one of New Orleans' Top 40 under 40 young professionals in 2019.

Kelley Benham French is the author, with her husband, of Juniper: The Girl Who Was Born Too Soon. The book, published in 2016 by Little, Brown, tells the story of her daughter, born barely viable at 23 weeks gestation. She was a finalist



for the 2013 Pulitzer Prize in feature writing for a newspaper series on the same subject, exploring the science and ethics of saving babies born so soon. She is a professor of practice in journalism at Indiana University in Bloomington, Indiana.
